BeeBase is the National Bee Unit's online database and responsible members should register themselves with BeeBase to ensure that they can receive notifications of any threatened outbreak that may affect their colonies. Registration with BeeBase means that in the event of a notifiable disease close to your location you will receive notification as soon as the outbreak is confirmed, not being registered means your colonies could be put at risk.
